Dear Parents,

Thank you for entrusting your children to us this year. We are looking forward to helping them learn and seeing them grow. You receive a monthly newsletter to keep you updated on what we are doing at school. Every day your child will have a time of free play, circle time, snack, and bible time. We get outside as often as we can while we have nice weather. Please dress your child in comfortable clothes and shoes to play in.

Your child has a cubbie that has been assigned to him/her for hanging their belongings. If you or your child are having difficulty with the separation each day, speak to a teacher and we will work out a goodbye routine to help with the transition in to school.



If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday at school please let us know. We suggest cookies, fruit, jello-jigglers or munchkins as a snack. Please NO cupcakes. We also have children with allergies so we have a very strict NO NUTS policy here at preschool. If your child has a birthday that does not fall within the school year we can always celebrate their "unbirthday" or "half birthday".



In circle during the months of September and October we will be learning the letters A,B,C ,D and E. Along with the numbers 1 and 2. We will also learn about the weather and calendar.

In Bible Time we will learn about God's word, Creation, Adam and Eve, Noah, and Joseph.

On **Tue. Oct 29th** we will have our dress up parade. Your child may wear a costume to school. Please, no witches, devils, ghosts, or things related to the occult or frightening to other children . Since the children will be parading, we ask that they do not wear masks for their safety.
