If your child is interested in joining this class, there is still room.



Our November theme for preschool and circle time is Thanksgiving. We will be talking about what we are thankful for and learning about the first Thanksgiving.

The craft projects we do this month will be to prepare for our Thanksgiving activities.

On Friday, November 15 we will have *Indian Day*. The teachers will transform the gym into an Indian Village complete with a teepee, an Iroquois long house, woods for hunting, a creek for fishing, and a campfire.

The children will dress in the Indian crafts they have made and we will spend a day living like the Indians did during our circle time.

On Friday, November 22 the children will get the chance to pretend to be pilgrims. They will don special hats they made for our *Thanksgiving Feast*. Our feast includes a variety of foods, even turkey. Sign up sheets will be posted before our feast so that you can contribute to our bountiful meal or help out on that day if you wish.

The letters we will be introducing during November are *H* and *I*. We will also be learning the numbers 3, 4, and 5.

On Thursday, November 7, when we will have *Hat Day*. The children wear a hat to school that day. We will do some special activities with our hats during circle time.
