Curriculum for the Month


This month we will be presenting the letters O, P, and Q and the numbers 7, 8 and 9 during circle time.

We will learn about opposites when we learn the letter O. With the letter P we will make pizza for snack one day, play with the parachute and have a pajama day. On Pajama Day, February 13, the children come to school wearing pajamas. They can bring slippers and either a small

blankie or stuffed toy.

When we learn the letter Q we will make a paper quilt for a craft.

In Bible time we will continue with stories about Jesus life, his healings and teachings. We will talk about what a *parable* is when we are learning the letter P in circle.


Registration for 2020-21 School Year

Kindergarten is Coming!

The school districts are beginning their enrollment processes. You should hear something from your local school by the end of this month. If you haven't heard anything by the end of the month, call your local school district to find out how they handle the process. Each district has a different procedure.

We are currently evaluating your children. The results of these evaluations will be sent home in March.



Illness

Please keep children home from school if they are ill. If they have had a fever, diarrhea, or vomiting within the past 24 hours they should stay home even if they are feeling better. If you have any question about their health, play it safe and keep them home. A child who isn't feeling well has a very difficult time at school. If your child has a communicable disease, notify the school. By letting other parents know what is going around, it helps them know when their own child needs a doctor's attention.

Safety

Please continue to work with your child on learning their name, address, and telephone number. This information is so important for them to know in case of an emergency. The children are really coming along well with this.

Reading Time

We like to offer reading during playtime (9-9:30) as an option for the children. The children love to have parents come in and read. If you are interested let a teacher know.
