Outside Projects:

- Lighting issues in the parking lot—Andrei Squire is leading this
- Front Sign: clean up and landscaping
- Front Sign: replacement with a LED type sign
- The clock on steeple needs to be replaced
- Lawn care issues: pricing, additional mowing, billing issues—Joe Mulone is leading this
- Steeple and soffit painting: scrape and paint
- Church entrance: coach lights replaced; Office entrance needs cleaning
- Snow Plowing: looking for a new vendor—Joe Mulone is leading this
- Topsoil and seed where the 2 stumps were removed
- Add mulch around a few trees on the west side of the sanctuary. They have some
 existing mulch from last year.
- Remove the accent lighting buried in the stone in the courtyard next to the windows of the Missions Hall
- Straighten the mailbox post (and stain the post?)
- The hanging sign that points to the office and preschool is sad! A new sign is warranted.
