#### Dear Parents,

Thank you for entrusting your children to us this year. We are looking forward to helping them learn and seeing them grow. You will receive a monthly newsletter to keep you updated on what we are doing at school. Every day your child will have a time of free play, circle time, snack, and Bible time. We get outside as often as we can while we have nice weather. Please dress your child in comfortable clothes and shoes to play in and a jacket.

Your child has a cubbie that has been assigned to him/her for hanging their belongings. If you or your child are having difficulty with the separation each day, speak to a teacher and we will work out a goodbye routine to help with the transition into school.



If you would like to celebrate your child's birthday at school please let us know. We suggest cookies, fruit, jellojigglers or munchkins as a snack. Please NO cupcakes. We also have children with allergies so we have a very strict NO NUTS policy here at preschool. If your child has a birthday that does not fall within the school year we can always celebrate their "unbirthday" or "half birthday".



In circle during the months of September and October we will be learning the letters A,B,C,D, E. and F Along with the number 1. We will also learn about the weather and calendar.

In Bible Time we will learn about God's word, Creation, Adam and Eve, Noah, Joseph, and Moses.

#### Dress Up Day

On Tues. Oct 27th we will have our dress up parade. Your child may wear a costume to school. Please NO witches, devils, ghosts, or things related to the occult that may be frightening to other children. If the weather is nice we will march in the courtyard, otherwise we will be in Buchanan Hall. The parade will begin as soon as all children arrive. Families are invited to watch the parade. You will need to wear masks and maintain distance from other families. The children may remain in their costumes for the rest of the morning or bring a change of clothes. There will also be a sign up sheet for party snacks in October.
