## Fall Classes

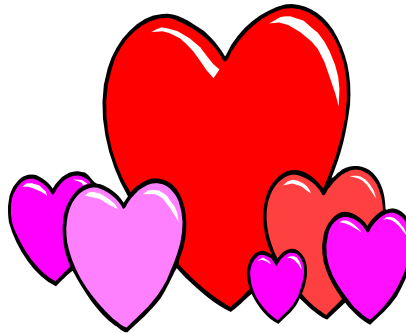
