
Registration for 2021-22 School Year

Kindergarten is Coming!

The school districts are beginning their enrollment processes. You should hear something from your local school by the end of this month. If you haven't heard anything by the end of the month, call your local school district to find out how they handle the process. Each district has a different procedure.

We are currently evaluating your children. The results of these evaluations will be sent home in March.



Illness

Please keep children home from school if they are ill. If they have had a fever, diarrhea, or vomiting within the past 24 hours they should stay home even if they are feeling better. If you have any question about their health, play it safe and keep them home. A child who isn't feeling well has a very difficult time at school. If your child has a communicable disease, notify the school. By letting other parents know what is going around, it helps them know when their own child needs a doctor's attention.

Classroom Supplies

This year we are going through a lot of cleaning supplies. If you can donate sanitizing wipes or hand sanitizer we are always in need of those. We also use some items for our crafts. Please save frosting containers for us. Also, if you have pony beads, wooden beads, rick rack, and wallpaper we appreciate those items.
