Messiah & Savior #11 – Mark 10:35-40, 14:32-42 – The Bitter Cup

**Palm Sunday** – When Jesus entered Jerusalem, the crowds received him as the Messiah and King, and waved palm branches which was a symbol for a \_\_\_\_\_ ruler.

Mark 10 – The disciples of Jesus assumed Jesus would use his \_\_\_\_\_ and his spiritual \_\_\_\_\_ to overthrow the Romans and bring the kingdom of God.

James & John wanted positions of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ at the right and left of Jesus.

*What did they think Jesus meant by drink from the cup or be baptized with his baptism?*

The Bitter Cup:

Job 21:20 – “Let him drink of the \_\_\_\_\_ of the Almighty.”

Psalms 75 – In the hand of the Lord is a cup...and all the \_\_\_\_\_ of the earth will drink it.

Jeremiah 25 - This is what the Lord, the God of Israel said: ‘Take from my hand this cup filled with the wine of my \_\_\_\_\_ and make all the \_\_\_\_\_ to whom I send you drink it...’

## Sermon Scripture Passages – Mark 10:35-40, 14:32-42

35 And James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came up to him and said to him, “Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you.” 36 And he said to them, “What do you want me to do for you?” 37 And they said to him, “Grant us to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your glory.” 38 Jesus said to them, “You do not know what you are asking. Are you able to drink the cup that I drink, or to be baptized with the baptism with which I am baptized?” 39 And they said to him, “We are able.” And Jesus said to them, “The cup that I drink you will drink, and with the baptism with which I am baptized, you will be baptized, 40 but to sit at my right hand or at my left is not mine to grant, but it is for those for whom it has been prepared.”

32 And they went to a place called Gethsemane. And he said to his disciples, “Sit here while I pray.” 33 And he took with him Peter and James and John, and began to be greatly distressed and troubled. 34 And he said to them, “My soul is very sorrowful, even to death. Remain here and watch.” 35 And going a little farther, he fell on the ground and prayed that, if it were possible, the hour might pass from him. 36 And he said, “Abba, Father, all things are possible for you. Remove this cup from me. Yet not what I will, but what you will.” 37 And he came and found them sleeping, and he said to Peter, “Simon, are you asleep? Could you not watch one hour? 38 Watch and pray that you may not enter into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.” 39 And again he went away and prayed, saying the same words. 40 And again he came and found them sleeping, for their eyes were very heavy, and they did not know what to answer him. 41 And he came the third time and said to them, “Are you still sleeping and taking your rest? It is enough; the hour has come. The Son of Man is betrayed into the hands of sinners. 42 Rise, let us be going; see, my betrayer is at hand.”

### **Reference Verses:**

*1 Peter 3:18* - For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. He was put to death in the body but made alive in the Spirit.

*2 Corinthians 5:21* - God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

*Romans 5:9* - Since we have now been justified by his blood, how much more shall we be saved from God's wrath through him!

*Romans 8:31-32* - What, then, shall we say in response to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? 32 He who did not spare his own Son, but gave him up for us all—how will he not also, along with him, graciously give us all things?

*Matthew 6:14-15* - For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. 15 But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

*Galatians 2:20* - I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
