Circle: In circle time we will be learning the letters U, V, and W and the number 8.

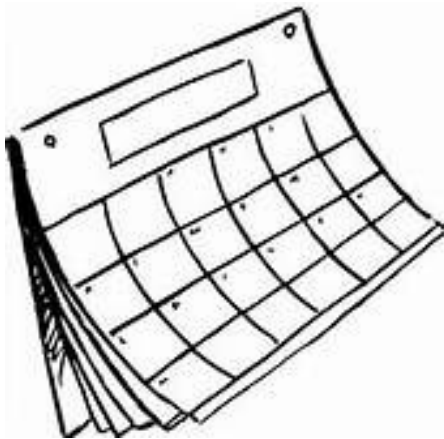

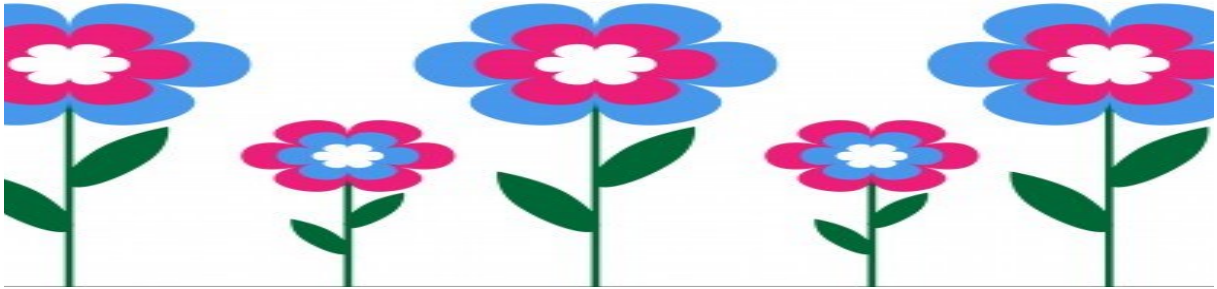
