April Activities

Spring is here and most of us are ready for it and the signs of new life which are appearing. The children are anxious to play outside in this warm weather. The ground dries slow and our playground will take a while to dry out so be sure your child has appropriate shoes for going out, it will still be muddy.

In Bible Story time Mrs. Waugaman will be telling the Easter story; Jesus riding into Jerusalem, the Last Supper, His arrest, burial and resurrection. After Easter we will learn about Him appearing to the disciples, the Ascension and Pentecost.

In Circle time we will be talking about growing things, and community helpers. We will cover the letters V and W, and the numbers 13 and 14. We hope to have a field trip to the Alplaus Fire House this month. Show and tell, with the theme of spring, will be on Friday, April 8th.

We will be getting our caterpillars soon. It is always exciting for the children to see their progress into butterflies and then to let them go.



Field Trips

We are going to go on two field trips this year. The first will be to the Alplaus Fire House. We are trying to schedule this for later this month. We are also scheduling a trip to Stoney Meadows Farm, hopefully in May. Both of these trips are mostly outdoors.

For field trips, we have parents drive their own children. We ask that you please not bring siblings if at all possible. We understand that sometimes you don't have a choice, but we need you to watch your own child in this environment which is different from our normal school routine. If you cannot attend, your child can still go. You can arrange for another parent to take your child, or you can let the teachers know and a teacher will drive your child. If you need a teacher to drive your child, you bring them to school just like a typical day.

Permission slips and details for the trips will be sent home about two weeks before the trips happen.

We ask children to wear the T-shirts we made on field trips.
