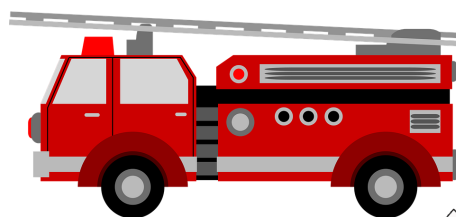
Zoo Day

Field Trips

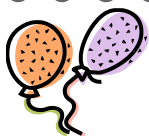
