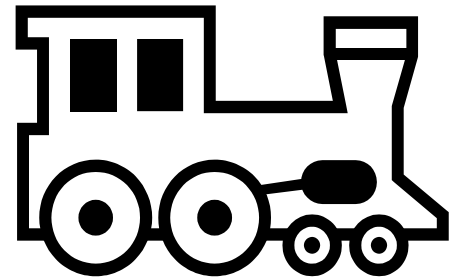
Circle Lessons

Our circle time theme for March is *Things That Take Us Places*, so we will be doing a variety of activities about types of transportation, traffic signs, and safety rules. On different days we will become, make, or play with trains, cars, planes, rockets, bikes, and boats. As we do these activities we will be introducing the letters *R, S, T and U*. We will also be learning the numbers 9 and 10. Show and tell for this month will be on Thursday, March 16th. For this show and tell we will have a transportation theme. As

usual, have your child put their show and tell item in a bag with their name on it. When they arrive at school, the children should put the bag into our show and tell basket.

March 23 is Transportation Day where the gym gets turned into Kidsville for a fun event.

On March 24th we will have our Teddy Bear Day. Children should bring their favorite teddy bear in to



school with them that day. The teddy bears will accompany the children during all of their activities, and for snack we will have teddy bear picnics in the classrooms.

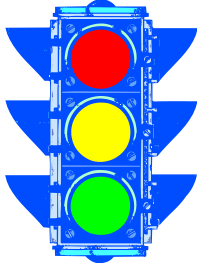
We will also talk about the coming of spring and be looking for signs of its arrival.

Getting ready for Kindergarten

We have been hard at work, evaluating the children to measure the progress they have made so far this year. Children progress in different areas at different rates. These evaluations are to give you an idea of what we see as you go through the Kindergarten registration process. Later this month we will be sending home the results of those evaluations. If the results are not what you were expecting, feel free to discuss them with one of the teachers. Many children are very different in school than they are at home. If you have any questions we will be glad to answer them.



Field Trips

We have some field trips scheduled. Dates for trips are on the front of this newsletter. You will be getting sign-up sheets for each trip. The forms will come home about two weeks before the trip. Fill out the permission slips letting us know if your child is coming and if you are coming as well. If you cannot attend, your child still can. They can ride with a teacher. You would bring your child and their car seat to school and then meet us back at school. If the trip has an admission fee, you pay that to us when you turn your form in.

The trip on April 26 is to Universal Preservation Hall in Saratoga. We have to submit our payment to them a month in advance of the show so that permission slip will come out soon. We reserved a block of seats and may have a few extra. If we do, you will be allowed to sign up for a lottery to bring either an extra adult or a sibling. You may bring siblings to the fire house, make sure to let us know if you are. We ask that you please *not* bring siblings to Sheep to Shawl. The rooms at Brookside are small and it gets quite crowded in there.
