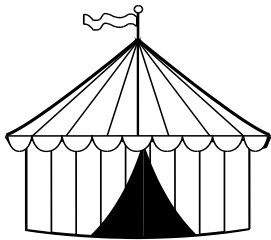

On Friday, October 27th East Glenville Preschool will be putting on our annual Circus.

For Circus Day, your child should wear a costume to school. The costume can be a circus performer, animal, something related to a circus, or any costume except witches, devils, ghosts, or things related to the occult or that could be frightening to other children. Since the children will be parading and performing we ask that they NOT wear

full face masks covering their eyes as part of their costume.

After you drop your child off in their classroom, you are encouraged to proceed to Buchanan Hall (the gym) to wait for our Circus performance to begin. There will be some chairs under the big top, but not enough for everyone. Younger siblings may sit on the floor in front of the chairs. We ask that the chairs be left for grandparents or those with tiny babies; and parents

who are able to stand, stand behind the chairs for the show.

We hope to start our circus around 9:15. Feel free to take pictures during the parade and performance which will last about a half hour.

After the parade the children will have a circus party. They may remain in their costumes or bring a change of clothes. There will be a sign-up sheet for party snacks going up in the middle of the month.



School Year Off to a Great Start

The children are adjusting well to the school routines and environment. We are looking forward to this being a great year together.

We regularly pray for your children and would appreciate you praying for

us as we serve your children.

In Bible Story time this month Mrs. Waugaman will be teaching about Noah and Joseph and starting the story of Moses.

In Circle time our theme for this month is the circus. We will learn about the cir-

cus, and practice for our circus performance. We will also cover the letters B, C, D, and E, the numbers 2 and 3 and have a Show and Tell Day.



Rocks Needed

During the winter when we learn about the letter R we will need a rock for each child for a craft we make. If you could look with your child for a rock about the size of a fist and bring it in to school once you find one, that would help us a lot. Thank you to those who already did!

There are volunteer opportunities for interested parents (and grandparents). Occasionally we need our smocks washed, we need help preparing craft supplies, and sometimes when we paint we could use extra hands (from 9-9:30). There is a sign-up sheet on a small table by the exit door for these opportunities. We also look for parents to be helper substitutes in the classroom. (there is a small financial compensation for substitutes).

Show and Tell—October 20th



On Friday, October 20, we will have our first Show and Tell day. For this first Show and Tell our theme is “your favorites”. Your child may bring in their favorite something to show their classmates. Please put the item in a bag and

label the bag with your child’s name. When they come to class they are to put the show and tell bag in the basket that will be near the door of their classroom. When we are ready to do show and tell, we get the basket

out and pull out the bags, one at a time, and have the children come up for sharing their item. If your child really wants to bring something fragile or breakable, please do not put the bag in the basket, but give it to a teacher.

Other Preschool Information

- On nice days we try to play outside, so be sure your child has a jacket warm enough for the weather.
- Tuition is \$168 per month for 3 days per week and \$224 for four days. It is due the beginning of each month.
- We are looking for wrapped candy for our Christmas Pinata party. We accept donations of leftover trick-or-treat candy for this need.
- Reminder: The Christmas Program will be on Thursday, December 21st with a snow date of Friday, December 22.
- Children love the pond in the courtyard. Please remember to keep a close eye on your children when they look at it and DON'T let them throw anything in it as this clogs the plumbing.
- We have a Pie Sale Fundraiser in the fall. Order forms are available in October and due back by Nov. 3. Pies are distributed for Thanksgiving.
