Christmas Events

Our Bible story for December will be the Christmas story. We will include the angel's visits, Jesus' birth, the shepherd's coming, and the kings' visit. As we learn the story, the children will get to try the various parts for the play they will perform during the Christmas program.

Our Circle Time lessons for the month will help us prepare for Christmas. We will spend the whole month talking about the letter **J** since we are preparing for Jesus' birth. Each day we will learn where a different Christmas tradition originated. We will learn a little about the country each tradition came from and how the tradition relates to Christmas. We will start in the US with candy canes. We will also travel to Germany for the Christmas tree, Ireland for candles in windows, Iran to talk about the wise men, Italy for our nativity scene, Holland for wooden shoes and stockings, and Sri Lanka for paperchains.

Our annual Christmas Program will be held on Thursday, December 19th. In case of a weather closing that day the program will be Friday, December 20th. Otherwise, on Friday, Dec 2oth, we will be learning about Christmas in Mexico on our world travels. We will have a piñata birthday party for Jesus' birthday. We need one piñata for the class. If you are interested in donating a piñata, let Mrs. Chevalier know. We prefer animal piñatas over popular characters. We are still in need of candy to fill our pinata if you still have candy from Halloween.

Christmas Program info:

When you come to school, bring your child to their classroom and then you should proceed to the sanctuary (not the gym) and wait for us to assemble. The program will start shortly after 9 once all children are here.

The main doors (in the front of the church) will be open so that your guests can go directly to the sanctuary.
Our program will last around 45 minutes. After

the program we will have refreshments in the gym. You will take your children home after the program.

Registration for 2025-2026

Applications for the 2025-2026 school year will be available in early January.

2-year-old classes meet Mondays and/or Thursdays 9:15-10:45am and a class on Tuesday and/or Fridays from 9:15 to 10:45am if needed. Children can register for either day once a week or both days.

We will be offering our regular 2 day, 3-year-old morning program on Mondays and Tuesdays from 9:00am to 11:30am. We are also offering an optional third day on Wednesdays from 9:00am to 11:30am. Children must be potty-trained to participate in the Wednesday enhanced program.

The 4-year-old morning programs meet on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 9:00-11:30am. We will also be offering the Tuesday morning enhanced class for 4-year-olds. This class offers more hands on activities, expands on topics we have learned in the 4-year-old program, and offers some new things. The focus will include, but not be limited to, activities with phonics, math, science, and nature. Students who enroll in the regular 4-year-old morning program are able to also participate in this program. Any questions about the enhanced program, please speak to Mrs. Chevalier, Mrs. Waugaman, or Miss Mandy.

Current students who return an application for next year before January 31, 2025 are guaranteed the class of their choice. Beginning February 1st we start to fill in the classes with applications that are received from new students and do not guarantee any spots. The registration fee for all children is \$35.

School Closings

There will be no school from December 23rd - January 3rd. Classes for 4-year-olds will resume on Tuesday, January 7th for the enhanced class and Wednesday, January 8th for the 4/5 year old class.

For snowy or icy weather, listen to the radio or check the TV for information on BHBL schools. If Burnt Hills closes or has a delay, we are closed as well. We will also try to send emails and texts if classes are canceled. (If the weather causes a power outage Mrs. Chevalier might not be able to access the internet for the text service due to poor cell service at her house.)
