10" pies are available for \$17 each. Tea breads are available for \$8.00. There are also pies made without gluten available. These are 8" pies and they are \$20.

The pies and breads are picked up in time for your Thanksgiving table. You can also purchase gift certificates that can be used to get a pie at another time of the year which is great for Christmas or Easter.

One order form is attached. More are available in folders outside the classroom doors. If you get orders from friends or family members, please return only one form to the school with the totals of all your orders. Order forms need to be returned with payment by Thursday, November 6.

The pies and breads will be here for pickup on Tuesday, November 25 from 9am – noon or Wednesday, November 26 from 8-11am. Please indicate on your order form which pick up time you would like. There is no school on November 26, but someone will be here with the pies for your convenience. If neither of these times work, special pickup arrangements can be made ahead of time by speaking with Miss Mandy.

Allergen information:

All Mourningkill pies and breads are hand made in their bake shop.

All breads contain wheat.

All pies contain milk and soy.

Made without gluten pies are made at a separate time from traditional pies when all surfaces have been carefully cleaned. The gluten-free flour blend used in these pies does contain almond flour. The pies are not certified gluten-free, but great care is taken to keep these pies from being contaminated by gluten. Because they are made in the same facility that makes gluten-containing products, they may not be safe for those with severe wheat allergies.

If a pie or bread contains nuts, it is indicated on the order form. Care is taken to avoid cross-contamination, however, nut containing products may be made at the same time as nut-free. Those with severe nut allergies should be advised that cross-contamination is unlikely but is possible.
